- **But Be Prepared...**Ice dams can still occur in areas where the average temperature is above 25°F (not to mention wind-driven rain)
- **Avoid The Risks...**If you are in an area that requires Leak Barrier protection, you could be putting your insurance coverage at risk by not installing it!

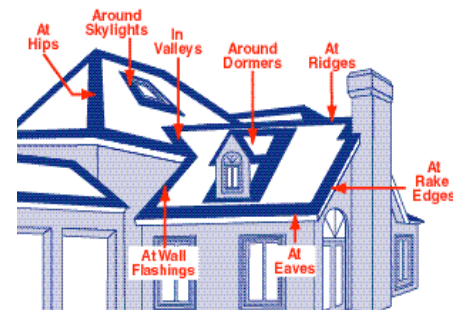
